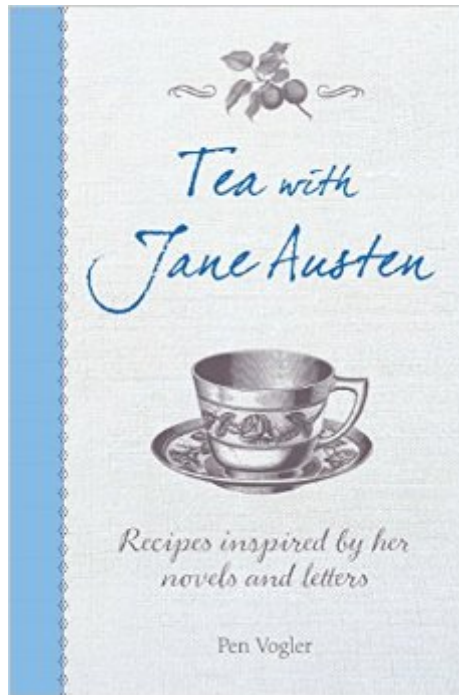

Each of the twenty-one recipes included within offers insights into the delicious treats and baked goods served with tea at the time. The recipes themselves are clearly written and explained, in both US and UK measurements. Each usually includes specific references from the books where they are mentioned, along with original recipes

from the period. There are also numerous illustrations in period style, beautiful photographs of the finished delights, with beautiful fonts and layouts, and lots of little borders, background patterns and more, which I think make the book into a wonderful gift for any Austen fan.
